Dear Vice Chancellor / Dean / HOD / Professor In-charge,

*Surakshit Khadya Abhiyan* (SKA) which, in English means **"Safe Food Mission for All",**which is aligned to Government's *Swachh Bharat Abhiyan*, was launched in 2015 by Shri Ram Vilas Paswan, Union Minister for Consumer Affairs, Govt. of India with the objective of promoting food safety in the country.

One of the initiatives of SKA is dedicated to building capacity of the students of food science towards securing the future of Food Safety globally. In this regard, three short-term courses in food safety areas have been designed and these have been forwarded by FSSAI to the Universities for introduction in their curriculum. Since Quiz contests are a fun way to sensitize and inculcate knowledge on Food Safety and Hygiene Practices, CII SKA conducted the Pan Asia Quiz Competition on Food Safety for under-graduate students of food technology / food safety / food microbiology / nutrition with the participation from 165 Colleges from 10 Countries resulting in a Grand Finale in December 2018.

The third initiative launched in 2018 was a**CII FACE – SKA Merit cum Means Scholarship Grant** for under-graduate students in areas of Food Technology / Microbiology / Nutrition and Home Science. The scholarship aimed to assist the highly needy, yet meritorious students who, due to lack of financial resources are not in a position to pursue food science education.

In the very first year of its launch, more than 500 applications were received from Food Colleges across the country. The initiative received an overwhelming response from stakeholders with financial support for the students. Based on their academic performance, family income and status of states they come from, 61 Students benefitted from the scholarship scheme with an amount of Rs. 25000 each. A Certificate of Scholarship has also be given to the selected students.

It gives me immense pleasure to inform that this year, CII – SKA would once again like to offer **CII FACE – SKA Merit cum Means Scholarship Grant** to under-graduate Indian students (B.Sc. / B.Tech.) of Food Technology / Food Microbiology / Nutrition / Home Science. Some of the **highlights** of the scheme are:

(1) The scheme is open to fresh admissions as well as continuing students;

(2) The scholarship amount covers tuition fees, hostel accommodation and related subsistence allowance;

(3) The scholarship amount covers allowance for purchase of books and study material.

The following are the **deadlines** for submission of completed applications along with the Certificate from the Principal / Dean / HOD / Professor In-charge:

(a) For Continuing Students – 15<sup>th</sup> August 2019

(b) For New Admissions – 15th September 2019

CII- FACE -SKA Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Scheme for Under-graduate Students of Food Science/Food Safety/Food Technology/Food Processing/ Food Microbiology/Nutrition/Home Science 2019 - 20

### A. Title and Scope of the Scheme

This Scheme is called the CII Food and Agriculture Centre of Excellence - *Surakshit Khadya Abhiyan* (CII FACE - SKA) Merit - cum - Means Scholarship Scheme. Its purpose is to support meritorious and financially under-privileged students of Food Science / Food Safety / Food Technology / Food Processing / Food Microbiology / Nutrition / Home Science at the Under-Graduate level.

### **B.** Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Indian students who have taken admission / pursuing Under-Graduate programmes in Food Science/Food Safety/ Food Technology / Food Processing / Food Microbiology / Nutrition / Home Science are eligible for the scholarship;
- 2. This scholarship would be provided to deserving students having good academic record but require financial support;
- 3. Student must have completed without any break:
  - I semester for II semester scholarship;
  - I and II semester, for the second year scholarship;
  - III and IV semester, for the third year scholarship;
  - V and VI semester, for the fourth year scholarship;
- 4. The student should have cleared all the courses of the concerned semester in the first attempt;
- 5. All papers must have been cleared with a minimum of 60% score or B grade;
- 6. The annual gross income of parents of student from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/-;
- 7. Calculation of merit-cum-means scores;

The merit cum means scores will be calculated by giving weight-age to parental income and merit of student as follows:

- Weight-age of parental income : 40%
- Weight-age of merit of student : 50%

- Weight-age of Specific State & Differently abled student (mentioned in point 10 below): 10%

8. The merit will be considered on the basis of weighted score for all semesters in case of continuing students and the marks in the 12th Class in case of new students, as applicable.

Annual income below Rs.1,00,000	100 marks
Rs. 1,00,000 - 1,50,000	95 marks
Rs. 1,50,000 - 2,00,000	90 marks
Rs. 2,00,000 - 2,50,000	85 marks

9. Parents' income weight-age will be calculated as under:

- 10. 10% weightage will be given to students domiciled in the following states during the final evaluation:
  - a) All 8 states from the North East
  - b) Jammu & Kashmir
  - c) Himachal Pradesh
  - d) Uttarakhand
  - e) Andaman & Nicobar Islands
  - f) Lakshadweep Islands

Differently-abled persons from all parts of the country will also eligible for the 10% weightage under this criterion (weightage will be based on degree of disability).

11. Hence, for the final evaluation for grant of scholarship, the following criteria will apply: 50% for merit, 40% family income and 10% for states / disability mentioned in paragraph 10 above.

### C. Amount of Scholarship

- 1. Actual Tuition fees of the Institute/ College / Course;
- 2. Allowance for purchase of books / study material;
- 3. Allowance for Hostel accommodation;
- 4. The number and amount of scholarship to be given will be based upon the availability of funds.

### **D.** Procedure for award of scholarships

- 1. The SKA FACE CII office will invite applications in prescribed format from students at a suitable time of the academic session;
- 2. Candidate shall submit their application in the form annexed to this Scheme along with all supporting documents;

- 3. Candidates may be required to produce all documents in original.
- 4. All forms will be screened for completeness and any deficiency/rejection will be notified and student will be given chance to comply with the requirements within five working days;
- 5. All eligible forms will be placed before the 'CII FACE SKA Scholarship Committee' for consideration;
- 6. The committee will finalize students list based upon the number of available scholarships;
- 7. Once approved, SKA FACE CII office will notify the list of approved students through email. A letter will also be sent to the parent of student as well as the Institute / College.

### E. Procedure for release of Scholarship

- 1. The College / Institution will have to send the annual/ semester exams report of the academic progress of the student without fail;
- The Director/ Principal/ HOD or Professor-in-charge shall attest duly filled form along with the academic reports and other relevant documents to be submitted to:
   "Executive Director, CII FACE SKA (Scholarship Scheme), Andhra Association, 24-25 Lodhi Institutional Area, 4th Floor, Lodhi Road, <u>New Delhi 110 003</u>" by e-mail at <u>ska.scholarship@cii.in</u>
- 3. The scholarship will be transferred by RTGS in the student's bank account.

### F. Other Conditions

- 1. Students shall declare any other source and amount of scholarship;
- 2. Student having any kind of disciplinary action (including exam.disciplinary) against him/her will not be eligible for any scholarship;
- 3. Student with attendance debarred, any back paper will not be considered for any kind of scholarship except for medical reasons as certified by the Director / Principal / HOD or Professor-in-charge of the Institute / College;
- 4. Scholarships shall be awarded to under-graduate students based on the recommendations of the 'CII FACE SKA Scholarship Committee';
- 5. Scholarships are liable to be withdrawn, partially or wholly, in case of misconduct, deliberate concealment of material facts and/or supply of false information.
- 6. The scholarship may be terminated at any time on grounds stated in para 5 above;
- 7. Students leaving the Institute / College of their own accord without completing the programme of study may be required to refund the amount of scholarship received during that year;
- 8. During the tenure of the scholarship, the scholarship holder shall not ordinarily receive any other scholarship, stipend, financial assistance or remuneration, etc. for any work except with the prior permission of the Executive Director of CII FACE SKA;
- 9. With reference to para 8 above, CII FACE SKA may allow students to avail scholarships awarded by external sources such as Govt. / Non-Govt. organizations (such as central sector scholarship schemes, scholarships form State Govts. scholarships from private trusts etc.), provided they do not come into conflict with any conditions of this

scheme;

- 10. The students selected for scholarship shall not accept or hold any appointment, paid or otherwise, and will not receive any emoluments, salary, etc. from any other source during the tenure of scholarship;
- 11. The scholarship may be terminated at any time on grounds of misconduct.

STUDENTS must fill the attached form and submit to the Principal / Director / HOD / Professor In-charge for verification and certification.
